- **Day 3 AVID College Facts**: Today's information focuses on free money, otherwise known as Scholarships and Grants. Did you know that...
- \$122.7 billion dollars was awarded in scholarships and grants in the year 2013 -2014, that's money that does not need to be repaid EVER!
- Two-thirds of college graduates received some kind of gift aid (scholarships and grants), which amounts to 1.2 million students out of 1.8 million graduates who received scholarship and grant money to pay for college.
- There is a wonderful scholarship available called the Bryan Cameron Impact Scholarship that covers full tuition college costs and other qualified educational expenses worth between \$20,000 \$50,000 per year AND 10 to 15 high school seniors can win this scholarship each year. Application is due in May 2019.
- Only NCAA Division 1 and 2, NAIA and NJCAA schools can offer scholarships to incoming athletes. However, Ivy League schools and NCAA Division 3 schools do not have athletic scholarships.
 The most sports with scholarships are Football with 85 available scholarships for student athletes and Women's Basketball with 15 scholarships available for female student athletes each year.
