The annual rite features skeletons, altars and other trappings of death but the ancient holiday celebrates life in its embrace of death. After colonization, it was moved by Spanish priests so that it coincided with the Christian holiday of All Hallows Eve "Dia de Todos Santos". The result is that Mexicans now celebrate the Day of the Dead during the first two days of November.
